

Greenlander - Bill of Materials

- 2 - 4' x 8' Sheet 1/8" thick Oak or Birch plywood (for hull)
- 1 - 4' x 8' Sheet 1/8" thick Lauan plywood (for deck)
- ½ Sheet (4'x4') 1/4" thick Lauan Plywood (seat, deck beams, coaming)
- 2 - 16' long 3/4" x 3/4" clear spruce, pine, or fir molding (shear clamps)
- 2 - 16' long ½" x 1-1/2" clear spruce, pine, or fir molding (rub rails)
- 1 - 4' long 1x2 clear fir (seat supports)
- 2 - 2' x 2' x 1" Urethane foam (optional for bulkheads)
- 1 Gallon Epoxy
- 25 yds - 2" (or 3") light fiberglass tape
- 1 doz. #8 x 1" stainless steel flat head wood screws
- 2 lbs 1d bronze ring type boat nails
- 1 doz disposable paint brushes of various widths (2", 3" and 4")
- Rubber gloves (I like the disposable kind. You can buy a box at any drug store)
- Respirators (for sanding dust) and safety glasses
