

## Mini Miss Bill of Materials

- 2 - 4' x 8' Sheets 1/4" thick Lauan or Birch plywood
- 1/2 Sheet - 4' x 4' - 1/2" thick Lauan or 3/8" Birch plywood (the Lauan is actually 7/16ths)
- 1 - 8' long 3/4" x 1-1/2" clear pine (or fir) molding for longitudinal & stem
- 4 - 10' Long 3/8" x 1-1/2" clear pine or fir molding for rub rails & chine logs.
- 1 - Gallon Epoxy
- Epoxy thickening agent - like microspheres or silica (Cab-O-Sil) - enough to make 1 quart of thickened epoxy
- 25 yds - 3" wide light fiberglass tape
- Thin nails or staples - brass if you plan to leave in-place, steel if you plan to remove.
- A dozen or so inexpensive disposable paintbrushes of various widths
- Rubber gloves
- Respirators (for sanding dust) & safety glasses
